Law and justice. Police work. Fire fighting. The Criminal Justice Academy promises a wide-ranging course of study, with opportunities to explore law enforcement, public safety, forensics, and the legal system. Students will delve into the psychology, science, ethics, and enforcement techniques that define our criminal justice system. The 100-hour immersive field experience will include opportunities for training with law enforcement, fire and/or public safety professionals as well as within the legal system.

College credits: 15 – 18, plus any additional credits earned through AP or college-level courses.



Education and human services are growing fields with expanding demand for qualified professionals. The Teaching and Learning Academy prepares students for college study and careers working with children and young adults. Field experiences will introduce students to a variety of practical real-life opportunities.

Graduates from this academy receive their Child Development Associate (CDA) Educational Endorsement Certificate of Achievement – the only nationally recognized certification for Early Childhood Education, which is accepted by New Jersey for working in many early childhood centers.

College credits: 15 – 18, plus any additional credits earned through AP or college-level courses.

College Credits

College credits earned through The Academies at Boonton High School are accredited by Fairleigh Dickenson University and/or The County College of Morris. Along with any college credits earned through AP exams, they are generally transferable to public colleges and universities in New Jersey and beyond, depending upon the policies of individual schools. Private institutions generally accept fewer transferable credits.

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
