**The School Nurse will review all immunizations before students are given a schedule. It is parents'/guardians' responsibility to provide immunizations within the given time frame to adhere to NJ immunization requirements. Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 8:57-4.6, all immunization records submitted by a parent or guardian in a language other than English are required to be accompanied by a translation sufficient to determine compliance with the immunization requirements; all translations must include the printed name and signature of the translator.
