

NEW STUDENTS/TRANSFER STUDENTS TO BPS FOLLOW THE GUIDELINES:

- A [current-year physical examination](#) and, as per [NJ state requirements, immunization records](#) must be submitted to the health office. [Emergency care plans/medical action plans](#) (if needed) are required to be submitted with the physical examination.

Transferring from another school in NJ

- ☐ **Current year** (has to be within 365 days) [Physical Examination](#)
- ☐ **Ask your prior school to send a health record (A-45).** If you cannot obtain the A-45, submit up-to-date immunization records.

Transferring from out-of-state or country

- ☐ A [New Physical Examination](#) from a provider in NJ
- ☐ And official immunization records from physician's office.

- ☐ PPD (T.B) test result for out-of-country as per NJ.gov guidelines.

****The School Nurse will review all immunizations before students are given a schedule. It is parents'/guardians' responsibility to provide immunizations within the given time frame to adhere to NJ immunization requirements. Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 8:57-4.6, all immunization records submitted by a parent or guardian in a language other than English are required **to be accompanied by a translation** sufficient to determine compliance with the immunization requirements; all translations **must include the printed name and signature of the translator.****
