Code of Conduct Agreement

Project Graduation is an alcohol and drug-free event, sponsored by the BHS Project Graduation Parent Association and the Class of 2018 Committee through the generous donations from the community. All graduates AND parents/guardians are required to follow these rules and regulations to participate in the event. The form must be signed by both student and his or her parent / guardian.

- I agree to arrive at the appropriate bus on time for Project Graduation and to use only the bus transportation provided by the committee. I will board at the Boonton High School parking lot or at the Lincoln Park Municipal/ PAL parking lot and will remain with the party until it returns at approximately 2:30 a.m. on June 22, 2018. **Buses will depart at 9:30 p.m. sharp on Thursday, June 21st.**
- Cars may be parked in the Boonton High School lot or in the Lincoln Park Municipal Lot.
- I agree to return on the same bus as departure.
- I agree to have all my belongings in the clear bag provided, inspected by a chaperone, the Police Department, or venue security before I board the bus and when I arrive at the venue. Note: Do not bring valuables with you there will not be a secure place to lock them up. Items permitted: Change of clothing, swimsuit, 1 towel, change of shoes, cell phone, toiletries in clear bag and key(s). Items not permitted, will be tagged and held until the end of the evening.
- I understand that I will not be permitted on the bus if a chaperone or the Police Officer suspect alcohol, drugs or vaping items are present.
- I agree not to partake of any alcohol, drugs, tobacco or vaping in accordance with federal, state, and Board of Education regulations before or during Project Graduation 2018.
- I understand that if I am suspected to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs before or during the event my parents will be called immediately to pick me up. Local authorities will be contacted if necessary as deemed by the venue or chaperones.
- I understand that the Boonton Board of Education and the BHS Project Graduation Parent Association and Class of 2018 Committee will not be held accountable for my safety if I choose to act in an unsafe manner.
- I agree to have a good time! I further agree to conduct myself in a safe and controlled manner to ensure the good time and safety of others. I will respect the authority of all chaperones, security personnel, and/or the Police Departments at all times.
